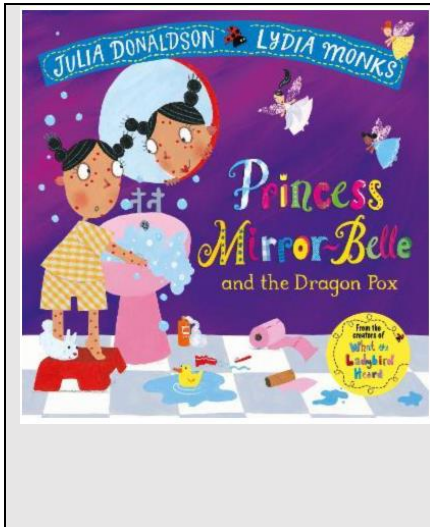
What part of the book will you not forget?

What is the Plot?

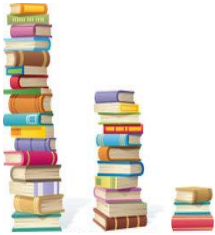
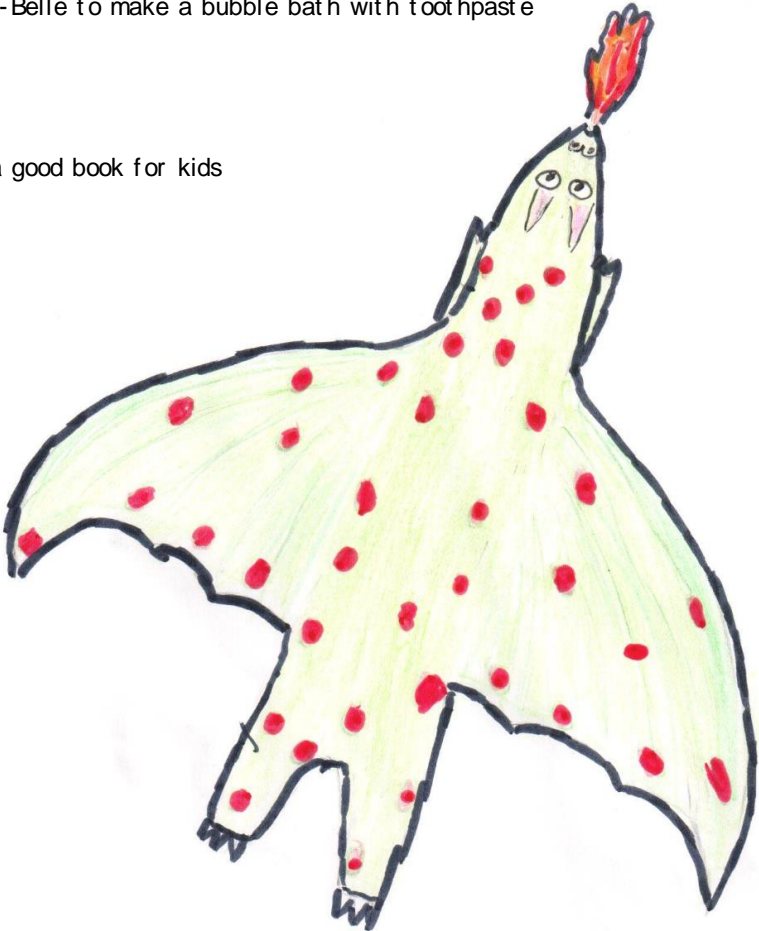

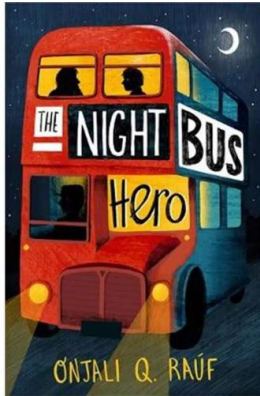
What part of the book will you not forget?

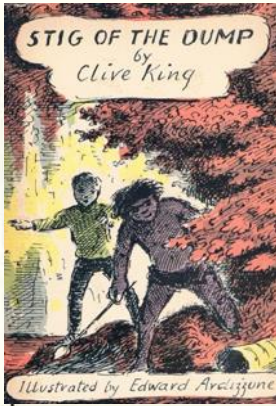
What part of the book will you not forget?
